### CHANGES TO SERVICE PATTERN



The PCC have unanimously supported a decision to start running **Messy Church at St. Boniface.** Messy Church is a way of being church for all ages, involving fun, food, crafts, a talk, sung worship and prayer. Its values are about being

Christ-centred and are based on creativity, hospitality and celebration. There are currently 3,748 churches running Messy Church.

**Messy Church will be at 10.00am on the third Sunday of each month, starting on September 17<sup>th</sup>.** On the third Sunday there will be TWO Communion services in the Parish, 8.00am at St. Boniface and 9.15am at St. Martin's. There will be NO 4.00pm service on the third Sunday of the month.

The first Sunday of each month at 10.00am at St. Boniface will be a Holy Eucharist service as Praise Together comes to an end in August.

On the third Sunday of the month there will be an informal, reflective evening service at **St. Martin's**, starting on the 17<sup>th</sup> September.
