Last week was the **Mission Day for St. Anne's Hospital, Liuli.**

As well as helping fund the on-going medical provisions, the friends of Liuli are currently fundraising to replace two miles of water pipes, and five toilet blocks. The pipes delivering clean, fresh water to the hospital are more than fifty years old and no longer fit for purpose. Unless they are renewed, the hospital will have to close. Taking out the old system and replacing it with a water system and toilets for the 21st century is clearly essential – but costly.

Just £3 will buy a new one metre length of two inch pipe (3,218 metres required!).
