### Today is our Mission Day for St. Anne's Hospital, Liuli.

Friends of **St Anne's Hospital Liuli** is a charity supporting a mission hospital and educational facilities along the shore of Lake Nyasa, Ruvuma, Tanzania, one of the poorest parts of Africa.

**Pipe dream?** The pipes delivering clean, fresh water to the hospital are more than fifty years old and no longer fit for purpose. Unless they are renewed, the hospital will have to close. Taking out the old system and replacing it with a water system and toilets for the 21st century is clearly essential – but costly.

**Two down – three to go** We have already funded two toilet blocks and preparatory work is underway – but another three blocks are needed urgently.

**Two mile run** The hospital also needs nearly two miles of piping for the new water supply – but just £3 will buy a new one metre length of two inch pipe (just 3,218 metres required!).
